The following items are required. If items are missing, your tax return cannot be completed.

Picture ID, Social Security Card (or individual tax identification number) for yourself and each dependent you are claiming, including spouse (if filing jointly, spouse must be present); W-2s and/or 1099s; employer ID numbers or SS numbers of childcare providers; last year's tax return, if itemizing; checking or savings account information if you want direct deposit of any refund. If you purchased insurance through the market place, bring form 1095-A.
